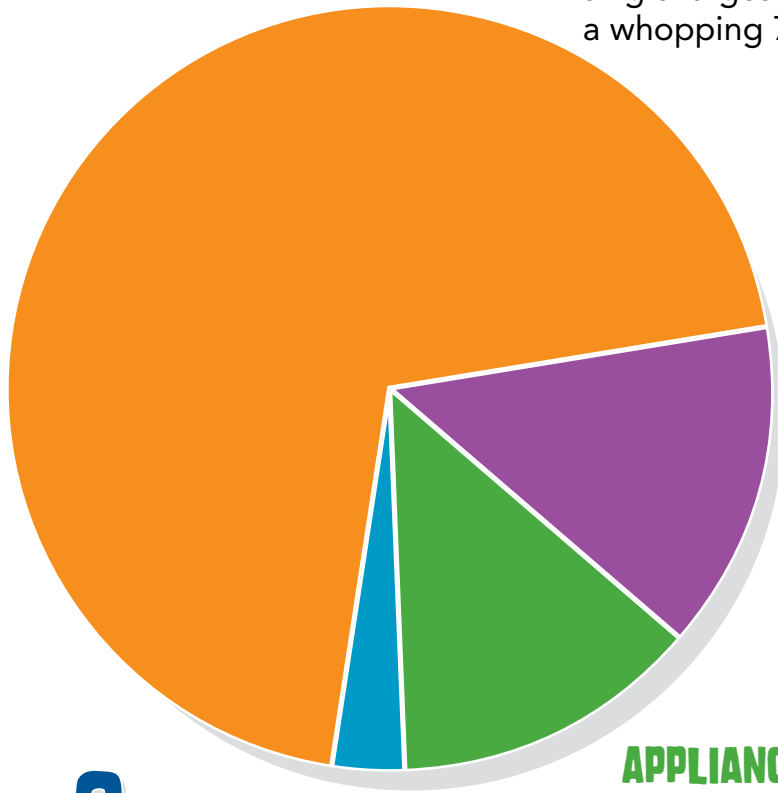


# HOW DO WE USE ENERGY AT HOME?
