There will be 12 questions over 12 days, with daily prizes and a grand prize draw of an iPad Mini on December 17, 2012. Individuals must 'LIKE' the Turn Back the Tide facebook page, 'COMMENT' on the trivia question and 'SHARE' their response with friends on facebook. Each time an entrant answers a trivia question, they will gain an entry into the daily draw, with a maximum of one entry per day. There is also a bonus entry available for sharing the contest rules on December 3, 2012. For every daily question answered, an entrant will gain another entry into the grand prize draw for an iPad Mini for a total of 13 possible entries into the grand prize draw.
