Official Contest Rules

1. CONTEST DATE:

The *Green Restaurants Trivia Contest* will run between June 10-14, 2013.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

This contest is open to all residents of Newfoundland and Labrador, excluding employees of the Office of Climate Change, Energy Efficiency and Emissions Trading (CCEET).

3. DESCRIPTION and HOW TO ENTER:

The *Green Restaurants Trivia Contest* will test your knowledge of what restaurants in Newfoundland and Labrador are doing to help tackle climate change. All answers can be found on www.turnbackthetide.ca/whatsnew. There will be 5 questions over 5 days, with daily prizes. To enter, individuals must 'LIKE' the *Turn Back the Tide* Facebook page and answer the trivia question on www.facebook.com/turnbackthetide. Each person can enter a maximum of one time per day.

4. LIMITS ON VOTING:

CCEET reserves the right to delete and/or disqualify any submission if it is found to infringe upon the rights of others, to be incomplete, offensive or otherwise unsuitable. CCEET assumes no responsibility for any technical issues, including computer, website and internet connectivity issues.

Failure of potential winners to respond within this time period will result in forfeiture of the prize and the selection of an alternate winner.
